Timothy Cotter will provide an update from the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA) with emphasis on the Recent Notice of Proposed Rule Making: **“Requirements for Intermodal Equipment Providers and Motor Carriers Operating Intermodal Equipment.”**

Cotter has been the Division Administrator for the FMCSA's MI Division since October 2001. He is responsible for implementation of USDOT's Truck and Bus Safety Programs in Michigan. These programs supervise federal investigators and work closely with other governmental agencies and industry with the goal of reducing large truck and bus crashes.

Cotter has been with FMCSA for over 14 years and held various of positions. He started with FMCSA in July 1992 as a *Safety Specialist* in Jefferson City, MO. Tim became the Field Office Supervisor for the agency's New York City office in March 1998. He later became the State Director for the New Hampshire Division office in September 1999.
